

MICHAEL J. YAREMCHUK, M.D., F.A.C.S

Dr. Yaremchuk received his BA and M.D. degrees from Yale College and the Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons, respectively. His plastic surgery training was obtained at the Johns Hopkins Hospital where he practiced before moving to Boston. He received special training for surgery of the face and facial skeleton during a craniofacial surgery fellowship at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Yaremchuk is Chief of Craniofacial Surgery at the Massachusetts General Hospital. He has been certified by both the American Board of Surgery and the American Board of Plastic Surgery.

Dr. Yaremchuk's expertise as a cosmetic and plastic surgeon is both nationally and internationally recognized. This is manifest by his multiple international invited lectureships and listing in the latest editions of Best Doctors in America and Who's Who in America.

A Professor of Surgery at the Harvard Medical School, Dr. Yaremchuk is an innovator and teacher. He uses state-of-the-art techniques and knowledge to care for his cosmetic surgery patients. He has authored three textbooks and over 100 articles. His most recent book ATLAS OF FACIAL IMPLANTS was published by Elsevier – Saunders in 2007. He has directed several national plastic surgery teaching courses. His research laboratory focuses on several topics including bone and cartilage as they relate to the facial skeleton, transplantation, facial implants, and the potential of bioengineered tissues to enhance the face and facial skeleton.

Although Dr. Yaremchuk has a special interest in surgery of the face and facial skeleton, he practices a full range of plastic surgery.
